How do I to Get to Tui Ridge Park?

Tui Ridge Park is located off Oturoa Road 17 kms from the Rotorua Town Centre.

From South and Rotorua:

Head north on SH5 out of Rotorua, turn right onto SH36 to travel through Ngongotaha, go over the railway line and take the second road on your left, which is Oturoa Road. Travel 7 kms up Oturoa Road and you will find Tui Ridge Park on the corner of Anderson Road. The main camp is 2 kms from the main gate.

From North:

Travel on State Highway 5 (Hamilton-Rotorua Highway), turn left into Oturoa Road on top of the Mamaku Plateau. Travel 7 kms down Oturoa Road and you will find Tui Ridge Park on the corner of Anderson Road.
